# **Chillicothe Transit System**

## **MISSION STATEMENT**

"To provide safe, clean, reliable, efficient and courteous transportation services to the citizens of Chillicothe to get from where they are to where they want to go. Transit Staff are committed to delivering these services in a professional, courteous, and helpful manner."

Chillicothe Transit System (CTS) is public transportation which is funded in part by the Federal Transit Administration, the Ohio Department of Transportation, and the City of Chillicothe.

## **RIDER RULES**

Kids under age 13 must be accompanied by an adult.

**Seatbelts** are recommended on all buses and required in all passenger vans. Riders must provide and secure child safety seats in vans.

All **bags and personal items** must be secured and take up no more than one seat on the vehicle.

**No eating** or drinking on the bus. **Drinks** must be kept in a sealed, no-spill container.

CTS buses are community spaces. Please **speak without profanity**, and **use headphones** when listening to music.

## All CTS services are free to ride. HOURS Mon - Fri 6a - 9p Saturday 10a - 6p Closed on Federal Holidays and Thanksgiving Friday, Christmas Eve, and New Year's Eve.

## **COUNTY SERVICE**

On-Demand County Service is provided one day per week to all county residents.

#### Service schedule is as follows:

Monday: Concord, Deerfield, Union Townships

**Tuesday:** Colerain, Green, Harrison, Springfield Townships

**Wednesday:** Buckskin, Paint, Paxton, Twin Townships

**Thursday:** Franklin, Huntington, Jefferson, Liberty, and Scioto Townships

Trips will be available at 7:00 a.m., Noon, and 7:00 p.m.

Trips must be scheduled one day prior to guarantee a ride. Same-day service requests are fulfilled when possible but may be limited if demand is high.

**Pick-up** is from any accessible address in the designated township and **return** is to the Library Transfer Hub or Transit Hub for further connections.

# ADA ACCESSIBILITY

All Chillicothe Transit System vehicles are equipped with **ADA lift equipment.** 

Service animals are permitted.

Passengers with **portable oxygen tanks** are permitted; tanks must be secured.

CTS information is available in **alternative formats** upon request.

Each fixed-route bus is equipped with a **two-bike rack**. Secure bike racks and a tire pump are available at the Transit Hub.


#### NONDISCRIMINATION STATEMENT
