NATURE OF WORK:

This is responsible and technical work in the theory and operation of a wastewater treatment plant. Work Is performed on an assigned shift according to the Wastewater Supervisor.

Responsible for the understanding of the theory and operation of wastewater treatment, to insure proper plant operations and a good quality effluent.

Work is performed with considerable independence.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

Operates all equipment in the plant with process control computer or in manual mode.

Detects and diagnoses defects in plant operations and takes corrective action.

Uses process control computer to monitor and control the water treatment processes, reservoirs and well fields. Must be able to stand, bend, squat, walk up and down several flights of steps, ascend and descend on a ladder, and lift heavy objects.

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE/TRAINING:

High school diploma or GED.

Valid Ohio Driver's License and insurability under the City's fleet coverage.

Qualified AFSCME members may be considered for hire as "Operator in Training" and must complete all required training and obtain required certification within two (2) years.

Failure to obtain Ohio EPA Class I Certification may result in employment termination.

Must pass a physical examination and drug & alcohol exam.

Courses in wastewater treatment and related subjects as required (OTCO, etc.).
