

Effective June 27, 2023, water rates will increase 2% and sewer rates will increase 8% authorized by:

Ordinances 23-00, 01-23.

The table provided below reflects the new rates.

Water & Sewer Rate Information					
Water and sewer rates are calculated using two separate criteria. All bills begin with a					
monthly minimum charge, determined by the size of the meter installed at the location.					
This charge is the same for zero up to two hundred (200) cubic feet. After the initial two					
hundred cubic feet, each additional one hundred cubic feet will be billed according to the					
applicable rate shown in the table below.
