Re: FTA Mask Requirement Extended

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) has extended the required use of face masks for all transportation networks that are federally funded, including the Chillicothe Transit System, through April 18, 2022.

This means:

- Masks will continue to be required on all buses and any transit property, including the transit hub. If an individual is unable to wear a mask due to a disability or medical condition, that individual can request for reasonable modification under the Americans with Disabilities Act and, if eligible, will be transported with a separate vehicle.
- Individuals showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 are asked not to ride. If a rider needs transportation for testing, the individual can contact dispatch to schedule an individual ride with additional safety protocol in place.
