

What is travel training?

Travel training is a valuable community resource to help individuals overcome fear or hesitation surrounding public transportation.

Riding transit can be intimidating for those unfamiliar with the system or the area. Travel training can help individuals gain the skills to

- Read route maps and schedules
 - Locate bus stops
- Obtain and use transit passes
- Recognize when the desired stop has been reached
 - And more!

Individuals will also learn how to modify their trips to take back personal independence. Travel training teaches the basic travel skills to ride public transportation, giving riders the confidence to ride public transit on their own.

One-on-one or group sessions available.

Do you want to learn how to use public transportation, but you are afraid you'll get lost or possibly miss your bus?

 - Help you find public and private transportation options to work, doctor's appointments, or social service agencies.
