



The Catherine and Holden Corzine Memorial Dog Park Rules

In using this park, dog owners do so at their own risk and agree that the City of Chillicothe is not liable for any injury or damage caused by their dog. Owners are responsible for reading and being familiar with the etiquette of the park and knowing their dog's temperament towards other dogs and humans. Owners are solely liable for injuries or damages caused by their dog(s).

Dog Park Etiquette:

- All dogs must wear a collar with a valid license and have current vaccinations required by law.
- Do not allow a dog to bully or mount another dog. If your dog becomes aggressive, exit immediately.
- Your dog must always be within eyesight and under voice control.
- Please properly dispose of your trash and your dog's waste in the receptacles provided.
- Food (dog and human) and glass containers are not permitted.
- Do not allow dogs to form loose packs.
- Handlers must discourage their dogs from running to meet other dogs at the gate.

Entering / Exiting the Dog Park:

- Be patient when entering or exiting. If the holding area is in use, please wait until vacant.
- Keep dogs on their leash until inside the holding area.
- Make sure both gates are closed and then unleash your dog in the enclosed area.
- Confirm that the outside gate is closed before opening the inside gate to allow your dog to enter the park.
- Do the reverse when exiting.
- Both gates should never be open at the same time.
- Ensure that both gates are closed after exiting the holding area.

If a Fight Occurs:

- Never reach your hands into the middle of a dog fight.
- Distract the dogs and divert their attention. Throwing water on the dogs or a loud whistle could work.
- If your dog is not in the fight, make sure they do not join.
- If a fight occurs, control your dog and move them away to a safe area.
- When warranted, exchange contact information with the other dog owner.
