Please make sure each person participating in the parade are aware of the following rules:

1. Parade Date/Time: Saturday, October 21st Parade begins at 10 a.m., promptly. Line up begins at South Sumter High School at 8:00 a.m. All parade entrants must check in with Parade Staff at the school entrance, to be directed where to assemble. The parade will travel down Main Street and end at Parkhill Avenue.
2. Walkers/ Drop-Offs: All walkers and drop offs must park first and walk or be dropped off in front of the school office parking area. Please DO NOT USE THE BUS LOOP – it is reserved for vehicular entries only! Walkers under the age of 12 must be with an organized group. The parade route is approximately 1 ½ miles long and it can be extremely warm. All children should be supervised and kept well hydrated. All walkers should be physically prepared.
3. Field Line up Instructions: For the safety of other parade participants, please DO NOT MOVE YOUR PARADE ENTRY once you are parked on the field.
4. Parade entry dimensions: Entries should NOT exceed 10' W x 36'L. This will provide for flexible turning and comfortable placement near other vehicles, floats and pedestrians.
5. Candy throwers: If you wish to throw candy, you MUST have walkers throw the candy from either side of your float/entry. Make sure they are able to toss the candy well into the crowd, onto sidewalks and grassy areas. This will ensure safety for ALL participants and parade attendees.
