Dear Edgewood Town Commissioners and Committee Directors,

I was invited to and attended an Edgewood Animal Welfare Advisory Committee meeting. I am interested in the work you are doing in our community and feel I have a skill set that will compliment others involved. I am reaching out to you today because I am very interested in becoming a part of the committee.

A New Mexico native, I have been an East Mountain resident for over 20 years and have lived at 6 Tucker Trail in Edgewood since September 2019. My career path has been in the pet, veterinary and shelter medicine arenas since 1980.

I am currently licensed by the State of New Mexico Board of Veterinary Medicine as a Registered Veterinary Technician. Locally in vet med, I have worked shelter medicine in clinic at Animal Humane NM, where we did an average of 40 surgeries a day, TNR program and general pet healthcare for low-income owners. I have extensive knowledge and training in infectious disease control of parvovirus, distemper, rabies isolation, caliciviruses and ringworm in cats.

I also successfully completed externships at VCA Vetcare & Referral Specialty Center where I worked a busy Emergency room, ICU, etc; VDS Veterinary Diagnostic Services (the state lab) assisting in necropsy, sample gathering, sample prep, cytology, PCR testing of bull semen for *Tritrichomonas foetus* and other infectious diseases; also The ANIC in Algodones which was a neurological imaging clinic for animals where in-depth neuro exams, CT scans, MRI's, Seizure animals and spinal and brain surgeries were a daily occurrence.

My experience raising, showing and training Golden Retrievers since 1989 has very much enhanced my life and the lives of many other people and families. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF EDGEWOOD that:

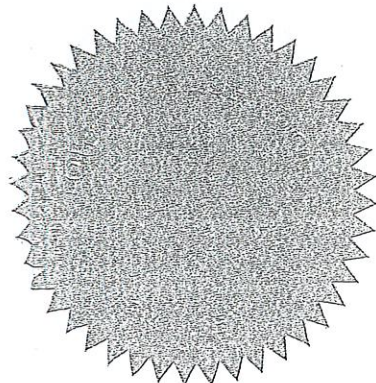
1. The Town of Edgewood has adopted the attached FY 2023-2027 Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan, and
