Road Dept. 4th Quarter 2017 Report

On Oct 12th the road dept. installed approx. 12 tons of 4"-8" riprap on the south side of Walker Rd just west of Southwood Rd. to correct an erosion problem created when walker Rd. was paved. Oct 24th we installed 732 tons of base course on El Prado Rd and on the 25th we installed 874 tons on Homestead Rd. Then on Dec 12th we installed 556 tons of base course on E. Hill Ranch Rd and then Dec12th thru the 14th we installed 1686 tons of base course on Mosely Rd. Due to equipment breakdowns we have been able to do limited maintenance on our other roads and have struggled to maintain them to our normal standards. I believe the town needs to start investing in some newer equipment and additional personnel if we expect to continue making strides to improve the town infrastructure for our residents.
