Notice of Funding Availability for FY 2024-2025

The City of Edinburg is an entitlement recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The City anticipates receiving approximately \$1,060,262 in CDBG funding for Fiscal Year 2024-2025, from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025.

Eligible activities include, but are not limited to, public facility construction and improvements, infrastructure improvements, rehabilitation of owner-occupied housing, and public service activities serving primarily low-income persons. CDBG funded activities must meet a National Objective and qualify as an eligible activity. The Grants Administration Department will accept funding applications from non-profit organizations until 4:30 p.m., Monday, March 4, 2024.
