## Housing Assistance Program

The City of Edinburg Housing Assistance Program assists eligible low/moderate income families with the rehabilitation/reconstruction of their homes. The goal of the program is to improve the overall living conditions in the community by providing safe, decent and affordable housing.

### Eligibility

- Applicant must meet HUD Income Limits.
- Applicant must be a homeowner.
- Reside in the City Limits of Edinburg.
- There must be no liens on the property.
- City and County taxes must be current.
- Applicant must have lived in the home for a minimum of 3 consecutive years.
- Applicant must currently occupy the property as their residence.
