



**NOTICE OF PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT NO. 3 FOR THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM
FY 2019-2020 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The City of Edinburg is a designated U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) entitlement community and was approved for special allocations of CDBG-CV/CV3 funds totaling \$1,176,704 to prevent, prepare for and respond to the effects of coronavirus in our community. This allocation was authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), which was enacted on March 27, 2020, as Public Law 116-136. The City proposes to re-allocate \$107,404.46 in unexpended funds to continue the Amigos Del Valle, Inc. Meals-on-Wheels Program.

This notice is intended to provide general information to the public on the proposed substantial amendment. A substantial amendment is required when: a) Any change in funding allocation priorities or a change in the method of distribution of funds in excess of \$75,000; b) In carrying out an activity, using funds from any program covered by the Consolidated Plan (including program income) but not previously described in the action plan; c) Deletion or creation of a proposed activity; d) Reduction of more than 25% of the proposed beneficiaries, when the proposed number of beneficiaries is greater than 10; e) Changing the purpose, scope, or location of an activity previously described. In accordance with 24 CFR 91.105(c)(2) and Subpart B of the federal regulations relative to citizen participation for Community Planning and Development Programs and applicable waivers made available through CARES Act, the City of Edinburg is amending the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan as a result of unexpended funds in the amount of \$107,404.46, and hereby proposes the following:

HUD will review the Substantial Amendment No. 3, and is expected to be approved by July 5, 2023.
