The City of Edinburg will submit its final FY 2023-2027 Consolidated Plan & Strategy, and FY 2023-2024 Annual Action Plan, to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), San Antonio Office, H.F. Garcia Federal Building, U.S. Courthouse, 615 E. Houston Street, Suite 347, San Antonio, Texas 78205, on or about August 16, 2023. HUD will review the proposal, and is expected to approve the Consolidated Plan & Strategy and Annual Action Plan by October 1, 2023.
