It is the intent of this Request for Bids to describe and ultimately make it possible for the City of Edinburg to accomplish the below mentioned **SALE OF REAL PROPERTY.**

The City of Edinburg, Texas is accepting sealed bids for the purchase of the following real property 1806 E.Cano, Edinburg, Texas 78539:

The Property commonly known as: 1806 E. Cano Street, Edinburg, Texas 78539; Legal Description: Lot Four (4) Block Five (5), Victory Subdivision, an Addition to the City of Edinburg, Hidalgo County, Texas, according to map thereof recorded in Volume 8, Page 11, Map Records of Hidalgo County, Texas.

The sale of the Property shall be awarded, at the discretion of the City Council, to the bidder submitting a bid in accordance with the terms outlined below, and providing the best value to the City.

It is the intention of the City to sell the Property based on the best value bid that is submitted.

If in the judgment of the City Council the bids submitted do not represent the fair value of the Property, the Council may reject all bids. Should any bid be accepted, payment shall be made by cashier's check or money order payable to the City of Edinburg-Community Development Department within three days of the award notice and the real estate closing shall take place within forty-five (45) days after receipt of the cashier's check. Provisions of the sale of the Property shall include: Provisions of the sale of the Property shall include:

1. For the purchase of the real property in "as is" condition;
2. For the conveyance of the Property by special warranty deed;
3. For the City to retain all oil, gas, and mineral rights;
4. For the Buyer to pay all fees, commissions and costs associated with closing the sale of the Property;
5. For the Buyer to assume all responsibility or liability for any environmental condition affecting the Property, or any clean-up or remediation that may be required by law;

The Property will be sold "as is" with no warranties or representations as to suitability for any particular use. Conveyance of the Property will be by special warranty deed. By submitting a bid, each bidder agrees to waive and does hereby waive any claim the bidder has or may have against the City of Edinburg, Texas, and the City's respective employees and representatives for the award of damages or attorney fees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid, waiver, deletion or amendment of any requirements under this Notice of Bid Opening, acceptance or rejection of any bids, and award of the bid. By submitting a bid, the bidder specifically waives any right to recover or be paid attorney fees from the City of Edinburg, Texas, or any of the City's employees and representatives under any of the provisions of the Texas Uniform Declaratory Judgments Act (Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 37.001, et. seq., as amended). The bidder acknowledges and agrees that this is the intentional relinquishment of a presently existing known right and that there is no disparity of bargaining power between the bidder and the City of Edinburg, Texas.
