Job Title: Fire/Fuels Crew Foreman

Reports to: Fuels Crew Supervisor

Division: Wildland

FLSA Status: Exempt

Supervisory Responsibility: Supervises Seasonal cutting and/or chipping crews

Position Summary:

The position of Foreman provides leadership, coordination, and direction to the fire-fuels crew. The Foreman typically works a 40-hours work week, though may often require additional work hours for incident response.

Essential Functions:

- Assist and support the supervisor with leadership, coordination and direction to the fire-fuels crew.
- Assist the supervisor with coordinating a chipping program, assisting in home assessments, coordinating mitigation projects throughout the district, and biomass reduction projects.
- Responding to wildland fire calls and participating in wildland fire training and best mitigation practices.
- Participating in initial attack, extended attack mop up.
- Perform other job-related duties as assigned by supervisor or designee

Minimum Education and Experience:

- Leadership and supervisory experience
- Experience with a chainsaw, chipping, pile construction/burning
- initial attack, and mop-up on wildland fires
- ICS 100, 200, 700, 800 within 6 months of hire
- FFT1, ICT5, FAL2, S-290 or ability to obtain

Job Specifications:

Must have knowledge of:

- Proven leadership techniques and methodologies
- The principles, practices, methods, and equipment employed in modern wildland firefighting and mitigation practices

Must have the ability to:

- Utilize excellent organizational skills with ability to work well under pressure of deadlines and changing priorities
- Customer service, communication skills, wildland fire experience and leadership/supervisory experience.
- Principles, practices and methods of wildland fire and mitigation practices.
