DD30, Lat 10

The trustees received an opinion from the drainage attorney that the county holds the right to maintain the tile within the state right of way. The Drainage Engineer is looking for direction from the trustees. State code states that they must cover the cost to repair the tile within the right of way. Vanness' & McVickers opinions are that they continue with the change order as presented to the DOT. The trustee consensus was to proceed as planned.

DD4 *WD # 185*

Lee presented an estimate for repairing DD4 from Lambertsen Excavating. There are a few variables based on the amount actually end up being used. He will be utilizing some 48" concrete pipe from the county that isn't being used. Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to accept the estimate from Lambertsen and move forward with repairs.

Nolte asked for an update on Bruce Harris' drainage issue. Lee stated that he had not gotten a cost to Colette and he will work on that this week.

The Auditor told the BOS that she had been contacted by an engineering firm regarding the possibility of hazardous pipelines coming through Franklin County. After brief discussion, the county will be utilizing CGA should this come to fruition.
