

**Board of Supervisors Drainage Minutes

August 30, 2021**

Present at Franklin County: Supervisors Mike Nolte, Gary McVicker, Chris Vanness, Auditor Katy Flint, Drainage Clerk Colette Bruns, Drainage Engineer Lee Gallentine on Zoom

DD 13 WO #171

Gallentine presented the Engineer's Report on Repairs to Main Tile for DD 13 WO #171. He recommends that the Main tile be replaced from downstream of the belly found during CCTV inspection to the uppermost exploratory excavation west of Mallard Avenue (approximately 1000 feet). Said replacement would return the Main tile to a positive drainage slope that is near its original design grade, as well as fix the multiple issues found throughout. Such a repair would cost well above the \$50,000 threshold and would thus require an Engineer's Report and Public Hearing.

Motioned by McVicker, seconded by Vanness to accept the receipt of the Engineer's Report for DD #13 and to set the public hearing on October 11, 2021 at 10:00 A.M at the Law Enforcement Center, 105 5th St SW, Hampton, IA 50441. All ayes, motion carried.

DD 63 WO #175

Gallentine presented the Board with two opinions of probable construction cost as follows:

- \$15,000 - \$20,000 for the following:
 - Remove the sand plug.
 - Reshape the open channel so that it has a uniform bottom width and cross-section.
 - Remove trees and brush within a set distance of the open channel.
 - Install rodent guards on both tile outlets.
- \$5,000 - \$8,000 for the following:
 - Remove the sand plug.
 - Install rodent guards on both tile outlets.

Gallentine recommends that all options should be completed and to cut and treat the trees and brush and not remove them. Bruns ran the estimate assessment report for this project and presented this to the Board. Nolte will speak with Bruce Harris to let him know his estimated cost and report back.

No action taken.

DD 30 Lat 10 WO #98

The Board discussed how to expedite this project and complete before the end of the year. Lee and Katy will contact the IDOT explaining that next Tuesday, September 7, 2021 will be the deadline for any comments to be received before 9AM. If no comment is heard at this time, the Board will plan to proceed with construction according to Change Order No. 1.
