Nolte spoke with Bruce Harris. Harris would like CGA to follow the option presented to the Board at the August 30, 2021 meeting. The Board agreed to have CGA remove the sand plug, reshape the open channel so that it has a uniform bottom width and cross-section, and install rodent guards on both tile outlets. Harris will remove the trees and shrubs within a set distance of the open channel.

DD 30 Lat 10 WO #98

Lee notified IDOT regarding the deadline, September 7, 2021. IDOT reviewed the CGA survey and provided comments /proposals before the deadline.


IDOT proposed to leave the existing tile under the main line and the existing tile under I-35 NB ramp in place, which will give a 3" backfall and to shift the start of the project downstream by approximately 1000 feet in the field to the north, costing the Drainage District an extra \$90,000.

Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to decline the IDOT plan changes which would cost the district \$90,000 more along with having approximately 3" of backfall causing poor drainage and proceeding with the original plans per Change Order No. 1. All ayes, motion carried.

Gallentine will notify the contractor and IDOT of the Board of Trustees' decision and will apply for the permit for Change Order No. 1.
