

**Board of Supervisors Drainage Minutes
Public Hearing Drainage District #30 Lateral 10
Of
November 14, 2022**

Present at Franklin County: Supervisors Gary McVicker, Mike Nolte, Chris Vanness, Drainage Clerk Colette Bruns, Auditor Katy Flint, Drainage Engineer Lee Gallentine, Drainage Attorney Art Cady. Members of the Public: Gordon Passehl, Bonnie Clark, Karen Zander, Jerry Passehl.

Motion by Vanness, seconded by McVicker, to open the public hearing on DD 30 Lateral 10 Completion Report for Partial Main Tile Replacement. All ayes, motion carried.

Lee Gallentine, Clapsaddle-Garber Associates, presented the Completion Report for Partial Main Tile Replacement on Drainage District 30 WO Lateral 10. CGA generated an Engineer's Report dated December 21, 2020 summarizing past improvements and repairs, and presented opinion of construction cost associated with said repairs. The Engineer's report was presented at a meeting with the District Trustees and a hearing concerning said report was conducted on February 16, 2021. The District Trustees authorized CGA to proceed with completion of project plans and specifications for the Partial Tile Replacement option and proceed with a bid letting. Brian Nettleton Excavating, Inc was awarded the bid and signed the contract on April 28, 2021, construction started on June 29, 2021, completion of the project was July 1, 2022. Total project cost was \$1,258,316.72, this does not include any administrative costs, legal costs, interest on constructions warrants, or damage claims. CGA recommends that the entire project be walked and reviewed. Please view full report in the Auditor's Office.

One drainage claims was filed by Dave Christiansen for David Dudley for 0.37 acres of corn damage.

Public comment was heard and there were concerns about the project deviations and how much it would cost the landowners. Gallentine clarified that most of this cost was billed to the IDOT and some to secondary roads. Gordon Passehl is concerned that the culvert under the east side of the drive did not get replaced. Gallentine said he did not think this was there before. The Board and Gallentine agreed to have CGA check to make sure.

Motion by Vanness, seconded by McVicker, to close the public hearing for the Completion Report for Partial Main Tile Replacement. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Vanness, seconded by McVicker to follow Franklin County policy, loss of crop from the previous year and to approve crop damage to Dave Dudley in the amount of \$383.27. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Vanness, seconded by McVicker to accept the Completion Report for Partial Main Tile Replacement and authorize final payment of \$144,324.83 to the contractor. All ayes, motion carried.
