A RESOLUTION SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS INTENT TO CAUSE THE PROPERTIES OWNED BY FRANKLIN COUNTY LOCATED IN OAKLAND TOWNSHIP TO BE SOLD BY PUBLIC SALE.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed method of sale for the property located at:

The East ten (10) acres of the North half (N ½) of the Northeast quarter (NE ¼) of section twenty-eight (28), township ninety (90) North, range twenty-two (22), West of the 5th P.M., Franklin County, Iowa. Also known as the Christopher Tract"

Will be to obtain through a public sale by sealed bid on July 11th, 2022, at 10:15AM in the Supervisors Chambers of the Franklin County Courthouse.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Franklin County Board of Supervisors approves the disposal of the ground.
