

**Board of Supervisors Drainage Minutes
Of
July 18, 2022**

Present at Franklin County: Supervisors Gary McVicker, Mike Nolte (via Zoom), Chris Vanness, Drainage Clerk Colette Bruns, Auditor Katy Flint, Drainage Engineer Lee Gallentine.

DD 30 Lat 10 WO #98

Gallentine presented Change Order No. 4 with an increase of \$8316.00: "During construction, Lateral 28 could not be found to be connected to Lateral 10. It was assumed to have been destroyed during construction of I35. This spring, it was discovered that Lateral 28 was intact with approximately 300' having been removed during or since I35 constructions. Reconnection of Lateral 28 required approximately 300' of new tile." This is inside IDOT ROW & will be invoiced to IDOT.

Motioned by Vanness, seconded by Nolte to accept Change Order No. 4 with an increase of \$8316.00 and make it part of the contract price \$1,165,973.50. All ayes, motion carried.

DD 30 WO #186

Gallentine presented the Investigation/Repair Summary for WO #186 stating "it is apparent that drainage capacity is being severely restricted on the main tile in the above mentioned 1,000 feet. The most straightforward way to reinstate the original design capacity is to replace the main tile at this location. This would both remove silt and the dips/flat spots. Whether this repair moves forward or not, the broken intake should be repaired. The anticipated construction cost is \$70,000-\$95,000 without engineering. This is large enough that a hearing would be required, but an engineer's report would not be required." The Board & Gallentine would like clarification on the Iowa Code 468.126.1, if no Engineer's Report is needed will the Board still need a public hearing or could notices be sent to landowners only. Bruns will check with Drainage Attorney Art Cady & will report back.

DD 59 WO #165

Bruns updated the Board on WO #165 DD 59, Weidemann removed trees & invoiced for \$6620.00.

DD 27 WO #208

Bruns updated the Board on WO #208 DD 27, Weidemann made repairs & invoiced for 4357.20.
