

Board of Supervisors Drainage Minutes
Of
April 10, 2023

Present at Franklin County: Supervisors, Chris Vanness, Gary McVicker, Richard Lukensmeyer, Drainage Attorney Art Cady, Auditor Katy Flint, Drainage Clerk Colette Bruns.

The Board met to further discuss DD 63 WO 175.

August 30, 2021 Drainage Meeting, Drainage Engineer Lee Gallentine gave opinion of probable construction costs, per the District Trustees request as follows:

- \$15,000-\$20,000 for the following:
 - Remove the sand plug
 - Reshape the open channel so that it has a uniform bottom width and cross-section
 - Remove trees/brush within a set distance of the open channel
 - Install rodent guards on both tile outlets
- \$5,000-\$8,000 for the following:
 - Remove the sand plug
 - Install rodent guards on both tile outlets

September 7, 2021 Drainage Meeting, Previous Supervisor Nolte spoke with Harris. Harris wanted CGA to follow the option presented to the Board at the August 30, 2021 meeting, to remove the sand plug, reshape the open channel so that it has a uniform bottom width and cross-section, and install rodent guards on both tile outlets and was agreed that Harris would Remove trees/brush within a set distance of the open channel.

August 15, 2022 Drainage Meeting, Harris was to remove trees/brush but did not, Nolte was to speak with him to see when he will complete.

April 2023, McVicker spoke with Harris and Harris said he had not yet removed the trees/shrubs and was not sure if he would have time. Harris would like to do the project himself but would remove trees at a later date.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Lukensmeyer to follow CGA's opinion of probable construction of \$15,000-\$20,000 at the Drainage District 63's expense. All ayes, motion carried.

Brunns will contact Harris to let him know and let CGA know to proceed.
