

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

January 23rd, 2023

The Board of Supervisors met at 1:00PM on Monday January 23rd, 2023 at the Franklin County Courthouse with Board members Vanness, McVicker, and Lukensmeyer present for a Budget Workshop.

There was discussion regarding budgets coming from boards & commissions. Currently there is no consistent way that these are being handled and it not only can become confusing for the Auditor/Budget Director, but also puts her in the middle of situations that are not of her control. For FY24 budget, the Board directed the Budget Director to follow whatever had been approved in meeting minutes from the Boards & Commissions in regards to wages. This will come back before the Board before the next budget cycle.

The Board discussed the levy rates for FY24. They looked at several scenarios for the reduction of levy rates presented by the Budget Director, but want to wait until they see what happens with pending legislation that could affect assessed values, which affect property taxes. Regardless, the Board will be lowering the overall County levy due to reduction of debt. The Budget Director/Auditor will be publishing notice of the max levy public hearing next week.

Motion by Lukensmeyer, seconded by McVicker to adjourn at 2:23PM until Monday, January 30th 2023 at 8:30AM at the Franklin County Courthouse. All ayes. Motion carried.
