

## Joint Board of Supervisors Drainage Minutes

May 2, 2022

JDD 1-31-86 4 Upper Tile WO 131

Franklin County Supervisor McVicker motioned to approve the agenda, Latham seconded. All ayes, motion carried.

Drainage Engineer Lee Gallentine discussed the options for work order #131 JDD 1-31-86 4 Upper Tile. Gallentine explained that authorization was given to use a camera to determine the condition of Lateral 4H. Lateral 4H south of the Franklin County line where it connects to Lateral 4 appears to have collapsed. The tile north of the county line has been replaced; however, it appears to have collapsed under the county-line road.

Gallentine recommended that a minimum of 130'-150' of tile be replaced or for more of a long-range repair, 400'-450' of tile be replaced. Gallentine estimated that either replacement option would come in below \$50,000; therefore, additional proceedings including a public hearing would not be necessary.

The Trustees agreed that it made sense to replace 400'-450' stretch of tile. Cerro Gordo Supervisor Latham motioned to replace approximately 400'-450' of Lateral 4H as recommend by Gallentine so long as the project remains under the \$50,000 threshold, Franklin Supervisor Vanness seconded. All Ayes, motion carried.

Cerro Gordo Supervisor Latham motioned to adjourn, Greiman seconded. Aly ayes, motion carried.

Gallentine will contact a contractor to make repairs.

### Additional Actions Recommended:

It is clear that the pipes of Lateral 4H are in various states of deterioration. Moving forward, the following are CGA's recommended options:

1. At a minimum, the collapsing concrete tile needs replaced at the following locations (approximately 130' to 150' of tile replacement):
  - a. From the south right of way line of Cerro Gordo Street north to the downstream end of the previous HDPE replacement (including the previous temporary repair for this work order).
  - b. From the connection of Lateral 4H with Lateral 4 north to the downstream end of the HDPE repair from Work Order 169.
2. In order to maintain a uniform grade and prevent entry of soil from future sinkholes/blowouts, all the existing tile from the connection of Lateral 4H with Lateral 4 north to the downstream end of the previous HDPE replacement (including the previous temporary repair for this work order) on the north side of Cerro Gordo Street. This would include approximately 400' to 450' of tile replacement.

It is CGA's opinion that the construction cost of either of these options would be below \$50,000.

Cerro Gordo Supervisor Tim Latham motioned to adjourn the meeting, Sis Greiman seconded. All ayes, motion carried.
