NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Village of Franklin Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at 7:00 PM or soon thereafter as the agenda will permit, on "Zoom.us ©." The hearing will be held for the purpose of receiving public comments on proposed amendments to the text of the Village of Franklin Zoning Code, generally consisting of the following:

1. **Creating Standards for Garden Enclosures** – amendments are proposed to Section 1268.28, Fences, to create standards for enclosures around gardens, including requirements governing their locations, size, and materials.
2. **Creating a Public / Institutional Zoning District** – amendments are proposed to Chapter 1240.08, Definitions; Chapter 1250, Single-Family Residential Districts; Chapter 1256, C-1 Commercial District; and Appendix B, Schedule of Regulations to address the proposed regulation of land in the newly-created Public Institutional District and to address other Code sections to account for a comprehensive regulatory approach to same.
