

**RESOLUTION NO. 2**

**(Series of 2023)**

**A RESOLUTION IMPOSING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE AND PROCESSING OF CERTAIN APPLICATIONS UNDER THE TOWN'S LAND USE CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Georgetown is a territorial charter municipality, acting through the Board of Selectmen (the "Board"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board is authorized to adopt such rules, regulations and restrictions for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, upon consideration of public comment concerning certain aspects of the Town's land use code, Title 17 of the Georgetown Municipal Code, the Board wishes to impose a temporary moratorium upon the acceptance and processing of applications under that Title.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Town of Georgetown, Colorado:


**Section 1.** A temporary moratorium is hereby imposed upon the acceptance and processing of applications requiring approval of the Planning Commission, Design Review Commission, and/or Board of Selectmen under Title 17 of the Georgetown Municipal Code.

**Section 2.** This moratorium shall take effect immediately upon adoption of this Resolution and shall expire 30 days from this date, unless earlier repealed or extended by action of the Board of Selectmen.

**Section 3. Effective date.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
