

**RESOLUTION NO. 3**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN CLEAR CREEK COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN  
REGARDING THE DISTRIBUTION OF SALES TAX REVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, on November 2, 2021, the votes of Clear Creek County (County) approved a one percent (1%) increase in the County-wide sales tax for the purpose of improving the safety of roads and bridges in the County, with twenty-five percent (25%) of the revenue from that tax increase being shared back with the incorporated municipalities in the County, including the Town of Georgetown (Town); and

**WHEREAS**, the County and the Town have authority to act cooperatively and also have the authority and capacity to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement pursuant to C.R.S. §29-1-201, *et. seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the County and the Town desire to enter into this Agreement to set forth the terms of the Town receiving its portion of the sales tax revenue from the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Georgetown:


1. That the Intergovernmental Agreement between Clear Creek County and the Town of Georgetown regarding the distribution of sales tax revenue for the purpose of improving the safety of roads and bridges in the County is hereby approved; and
2. The Board of Selectmen does hereby authorize Police Judge Lynette Kelsey to sign said Intergovernmental Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto (*see* Exhibit "A"); and
3. The Town of Georgetown hereby confirms that, upon the mutual execution of the agreement, the same shall be considered valid and in full force and effect and that there have been no amendments or modifications, except as set forth therein.
