**BACKGROUND:**

This matter has been placed on Council’s agenda for continued discussion.

As Council is aware, position announcements for a Pool Manager and lifeguards were provided in early March to the parks and recreation departments in Louisa County, Greene County, Madison County, and Orange County; the high schools (and swim teams, where applicable) in Orange, Louisa, Madison, Greene and Albemarle Counties; ACAC in Charlottesville; the Jefferson Swim League; the Ben Hair Just Swim for Life Foundation; and the Orange County Office on Youth. Past pool employees were also contacted—only one responded to say she is not available. Position announcements were also posted in Town Hall, on the Town’s website, on Indeed, and on the Town’s Facebook page.

Staff is communicating with an individual interested in being Pool Manager, and has also reached out again to two individuals who recently expressed interest in working as lifeguards. All have been made aware of lifeguard certification opportunities, including a certification class being held locally at the Orange Country Town Pool on June 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>.

To help entice applicants, staff is offering \$12/hr. starting salary, \$100 sign-on bonus, and \$175 reimbursement of certification expenses. Staff is attempting to have enough staff in place to open the pool during the July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend, and hopes to be able to have the pool open four days a week through the month of July, and possibly into the first week of August.

This information is being provided as an update and no action is requested at this time.
