## **2022 ACHIEVEMENTS**

- Successfully Provided 24/7/365 Law Enforcement Services despite being short-staffed throughout most of the year;
- Implemented updated Department Policy within the Virginia Law Enforcement Professional Standards Commission published parameters (Accreditation);
- Continued to implement ongoing training at department quarterly meetings to include the following topics: Use of Force, Less Lethal, Duty to Intervene, etc.;
- Two candidates successfully completed Basic Law Enforcement Training at Central Shenandoah Criminal Justice Training Academy;
- Awarded a VRSA Public Safety grant in the amount of \$2,000;
- Awarded two Local Law Enforcement Block Grants in the amount of \$3,190 and \$3,348;  
The two grants listed above were used to purchase a radar sign, which allows us to have a presence in more areas, and to update office furniture; and
- The Department has utilized the CESF Grant to purchase new Laptops and have them set up with a VPN and use of Hotspots.
