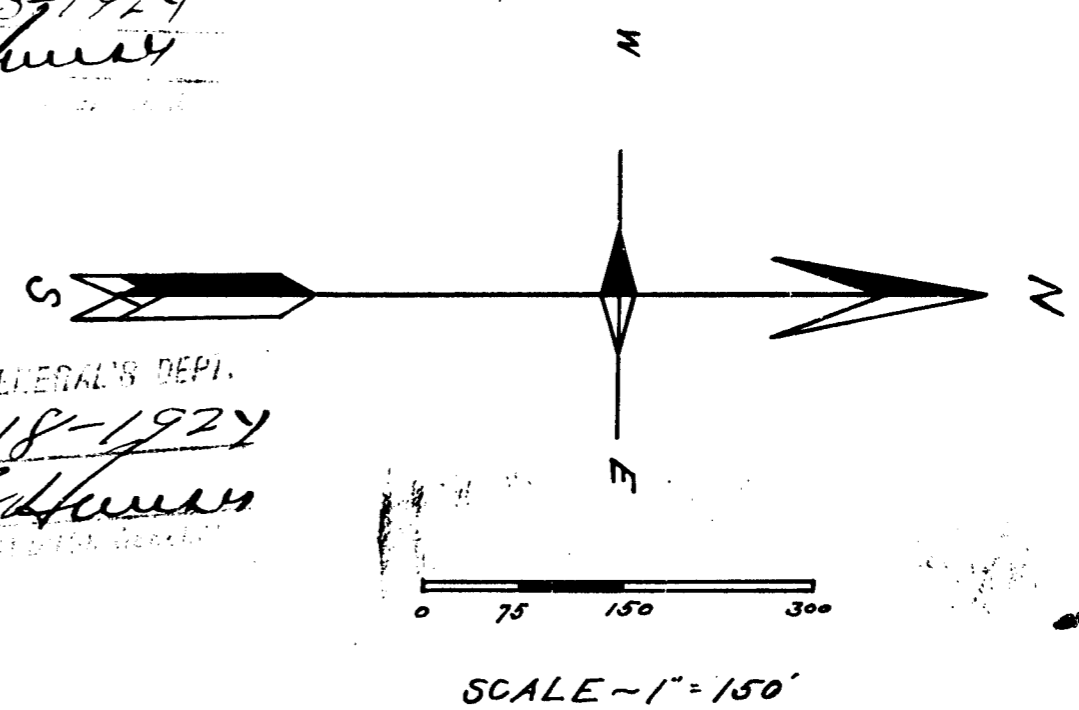

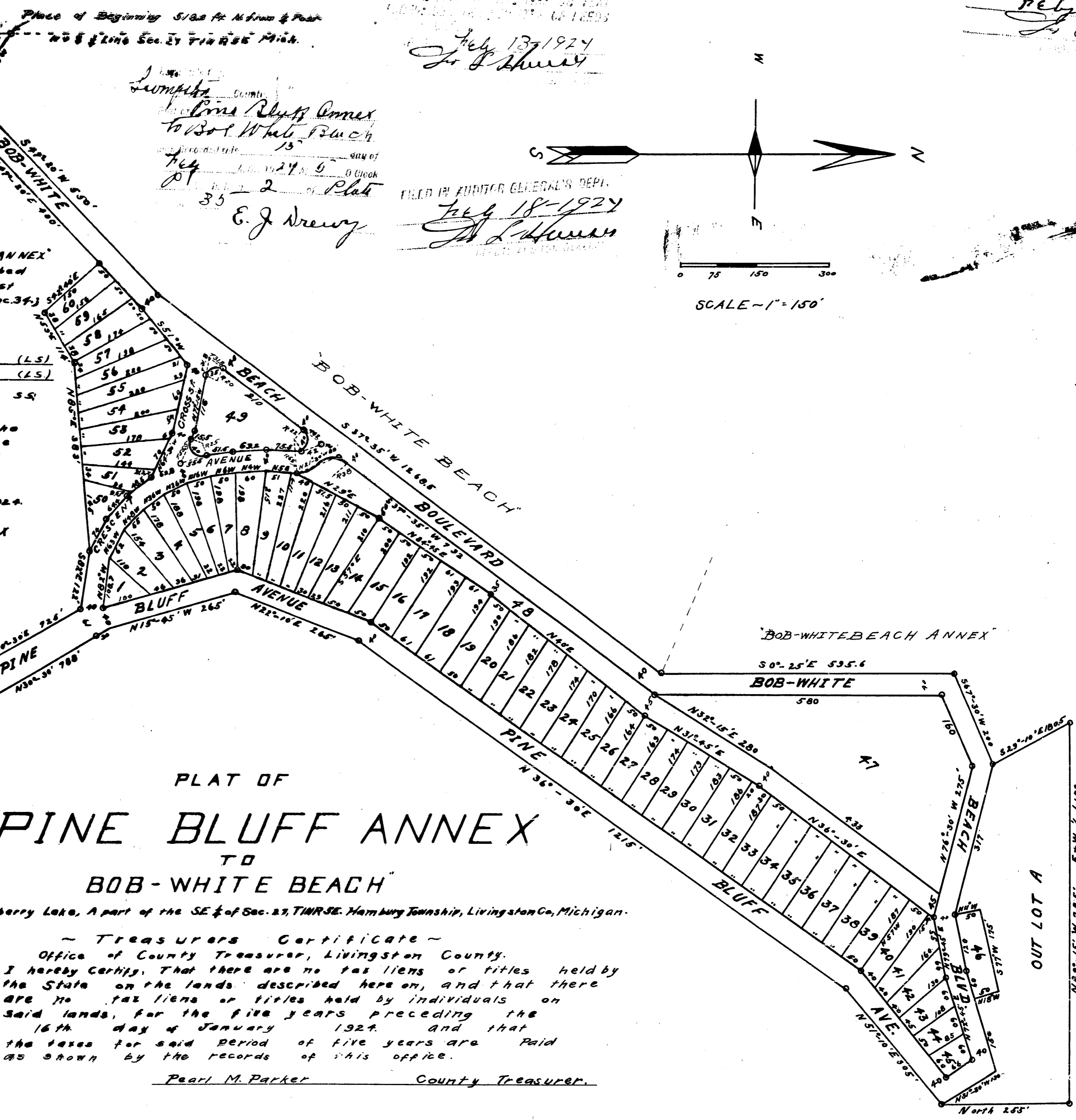
- Dedication -

 to "BOB-WHITE BEACH", and all owners of the following described
 land: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 26.; SE frac. 1/4 Sec. 27 except 7 acres on East
 side of N 1/2.; West 16.47 chains of W 1/2 SW 1/4 Sec. 34.; E 1/2 NW 1/4 Sec. 34.;
 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 34.
 All in Township 14R5E Michigan.

- DESCRIPTION -
 The land embraced in the annexed plat of "PINE BLUFF ANNEX
 to Bob-White Beach", Strawberry Lake, a part of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 27,
 T14R5E, Hamburg Township, Livingston Co. Michigan, is described
 as follows: Beginning at a point on the N 1/2 of Line 5132 feet
 North of S 1/2 Post of Sec. 27. at NW corner lot 36 "Bob-White Beach".
 Running thence as follows: S 0°-24' E 200' along 1/2 line; Thence
 S 54°-40' E 140'; East 40'; N 0°-24' W 180'; N 47°-20' E 400'; S 42°-40' E 150';
 N 35° E 114'; N 85° E 303'; S 82° E 122'; S 30°-30' E 725' to Highway;
 E 75'; N 30°-30' W 700'; N 30°-30' W 30'; N 15°-45' W 265'; N 22°-10' E 265';
 N 36°-30' E 1215'; N 5°-10' W 306'; Northeast to E 1/2 of Line;
 N 89°-15' W 785' along 1/2 line to NE corner Lot 1 "Bob-White Beach Annex".
 Thence along "Bob-White Beach Annex" and "Bob-White Beach" as follows:
 S 25°-10' E 126.5'; S 63°-30' E 200'; S 0°-25' E 535.6'; S 37°-35' W 1166.6'; S 97°-20' W 550';
 N 54°-40' W 140' to Place of Beginning.
