

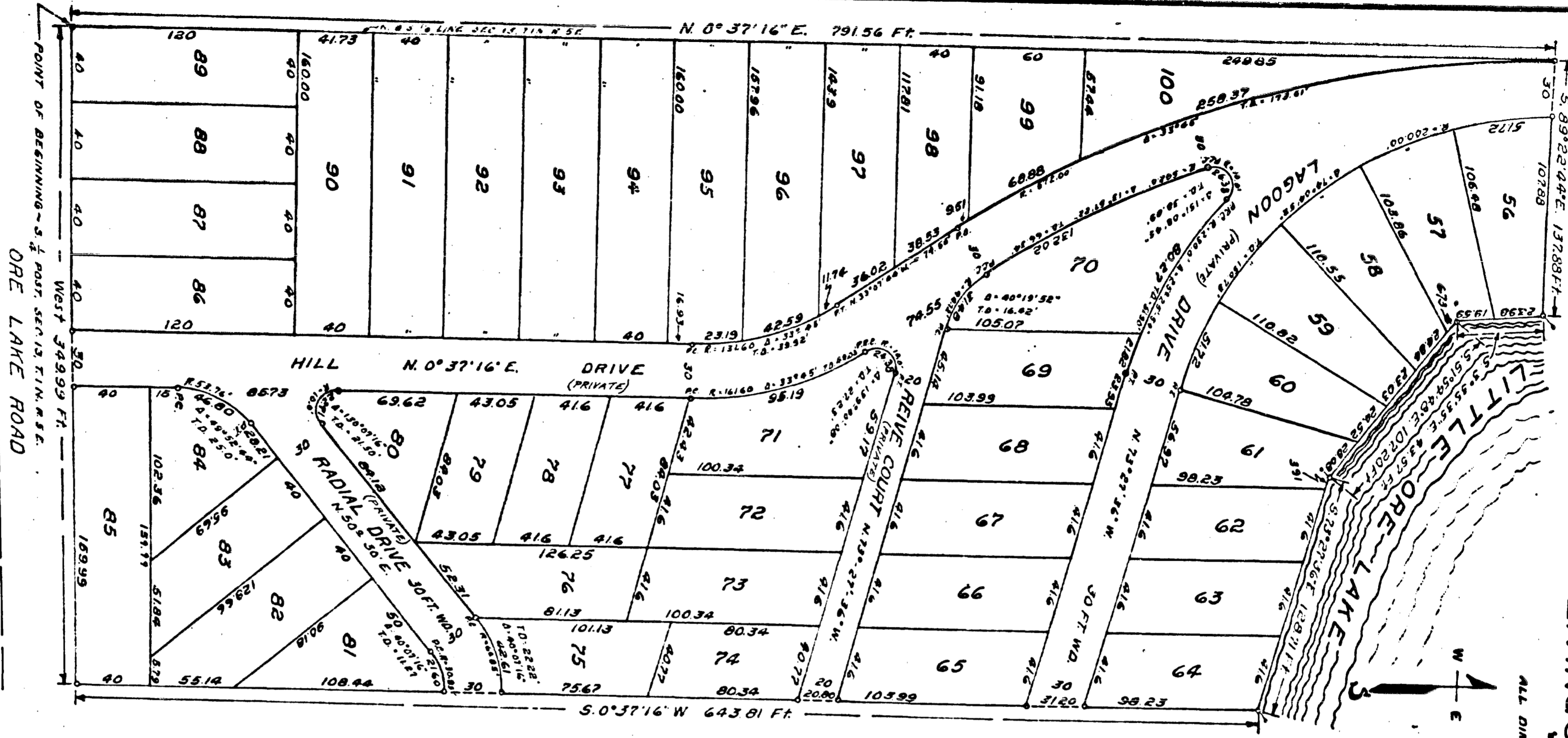

Livingston County Michigan, is described as follows: Commencing at the South 1/4 post See 13 T. 1 N., R. 5 E., thence N. 02° 37' 16" E., seven hundred ninety one & fifty six hundredths (791.56) feet along the N. & S. 1/4 line Sec. 13, thence S. 89° 22' 44" E., one hundred thirty seven & eighty eight hundredths (137.88) feet to a meander post on the shore of Little Ore Lake, thence S. 32° 35' E., forty three & fifty seven hundredths (43.57) feet to a meander post on the shore of "Little Ore Lake", thence S. 11° 54' 48" E., one hundred seven & twenty hundredths (107.20) feet to a meander post on the shore of "Little Ore Lake", thence S. 73° 27' 36" E., one hundred twenty eight & seventy one hundredths (128.71) feet to a meander post on the shore of "Little Ore Lake", thence S. 02° 37' 16" W., six hundred forty three & eighty one hundredths (643.81) feet, thence West along the S. line Sec. 13, three hundred forty nine & ninety nine hundredths (349.99) feet to the point of beginning for this description.
