Our next Community Clean-Up has been approved by the Township Board, and will be held on Saturday, April 25, 2020. Anyone interested in helping with the event, please complete the Volunteer form which can be found on our website at:

We had our first Amenities and Beautification Committee meeting on January 21, 2020 at 4:30 and there were about 10 participants. Most were interested in volunteering for the Clean-Up efforts during the Community Clean-Up Event, although there were a few folks that did adopt a few of the Township gardens under our new program. A formal committee was not formed at this time, and future informational meetings will be scheduled by the Parks & ADA Coordinator.

I have discussed changes to the Community Center deposit process with the Senior Director, Treasury and Director of Accounting. Due to the changes in how Parks and Recreation/Senior Center/Trails is funded, we are looking for ways to ensure that costs for Maintenance, Floor Waxing, Supplies, and Utilities are covered. It has also been determined that the current deposit process is cumbersome, as it requires refunds of old deposits and the acceptance of new. I will be working on a proposal for a fee structure that will eliminate the need to retain a refundable deposit, and hope to have the new fee structure in place by the start of the fiscal year. Fees will be set based on comparable surrounding facilities.

I attended several excellent sessions at the MParks Conference and found a great deal of value in attending. It was inspiring being around so many passionate people, who are making their community better one park or program at a time! The Grant workshops were well attended and informative, and it was great to learn from those who have been through it before.

The latest display by the Hamburg Historical Museum, in the lobby of Township Hall, has information about the Zukey Lake Ice House. If you haven't seen it, be sure to take a peek next time you are in. So interesting!



We are in receipt of a Park Use Application from the HCSC dated February 9, 2020 for use of Soccer Fields located in Manly Bennett Park West for their spring season beginning March 20, 2020 and ending July 28, 2020.

They anticipate 80 recreation participants, fall count was 49. Due to the small number of participants, HCSC does not require use of all 8 areas of West Park, and can limit their activities to 2 areas.
