The Hamburg Township Board of Trustees has scheduled the second public hearing for the Hillside Lakes Drive road improvement district to be held on Tuesday, **August 5th**, **2020** at **6:30 p.m.** at the Township Offices located at 10405 Merrill Road to discuss the assessment roll to be adopted by the Board. 

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE HILLSIDE LAKES DRIVE ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Township Board") has determined that it is desirable to act favorably upon the request of the property owners to finance the construction of certain road improvements for their private road, to be completed by a Contractor hired by the property owners of the Hillside Lakes subdivision, within the Township as described in Exhibit A (the "Project"), and including those roads located within the subdivision located in Green Oak Charter Township;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Township has tentatively determined to proceed with the Project in accordance with Act No. 188, Michigan Public Acts of 1954, as amended ("Act 188"). The Board of Trustees acknowledges that Green Oak Charter Township shall finance the entire Project by issuing capital improvement bonds (the "Bonds");

WHEREAS, the Township Board has determined to use Special Assessments levied under Act 188 to raise the funds to pay the Township's obligations on the Bonds;

WHEREAS, the Special Assessment District for the Project has been determined by the Township Board;

WHEREAS, the Township Board has directed the Township Supervisor to prepare the proposed Special Assessment Roll;

WHEREAS, the Township Supervisor has prepared the proposed Special Assessment Roll and has filed the proposed Special Assessment Roll with the Township Clerk;

WHEREAS, the Township Board has scheduled a public hearing on the proposed Special Assessment Roll and notice of the hearing has been properly provided;

WHEREAS, the Township Board conducted the public hearing on the proposed Special Assessment Roll on August 18th, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. <u>Roll Confirmation</u>. In accordance with Act No. 188, Michigan Public Acts of 1954, as amended, and the laws of the State of Michigan, the Township Board hereby confirms the Special Assessment Roll for the Hamburg Township Hillside Lakes Drive – Road Improvement Special Assessment District (the "Roll").

2. <u>Future Installments – Principal</u>. The Township Board determines that each Special Assessment may be paid in 10 equal installments. The first installment shall be due on December 1, 2020. Each subsequent installment shall be due at intervals 12 months from the due date of the first installment.

3. <u>Future Installments – Interest</u>. All unpaid installments shall bear interest, payable annually on each installment due date, at a rate equal to one percent (1%) above the average interest rate on the Township bonds sold to finance the Project. Interest on such unpaid installments shall accrue from the first day of the month in which interest starts to accrue on such Township bonds.

4. <u>Warrant</u>. The Township Clerk is hereby directed to attach a warrant (in the form of Exhibit B to this resolution) to the Roll and to deliver such warrant and the Roll to the Township Treasurer, who shall thereupon collect the special assessments in accordance with the terms of this Resolution, the Clerk's warrant and the statues of the State of Michigan.

5. <u>Ratification of Notice</u>. The form and content of the notice published and mailed to property owners in the special assessment district by the Township Clerk with respect to the public hearing held on August 18, 2020 and all action of Township officials in scheduling such hearing, are hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.

6. <u>Inconsistent Prior Resolutions</u>. All previously adopted resolutions that are in conflict with this resolution are replaced to the extent of such conflict.

The project will consist of repaving the existing asphalt on approximately 154,000 square feet of the following roads; Foxgate Court and Hillside Lakes Drive located in Green Oak Charter Township and including the 42,000 square foot portion of Hillside Lakes Drive located within Hamburg Township. The Contractor shall mill and remove the existing asphalt pavement, regrade and compact the base and then place four-inches (4") of new hot mix asphalt (HMA) pavement in two lifts. Contractor shall be responsible to clean up all debris from the paving operations. The street rehabilitation shall serve the properties within the Hillside Lakes subdivision and more specifically that portion located in Hamburg Township along Hillside Lakes Drive that is within the boundaries indicated on the attached map.


