RESIDENT RESPONSIBILITY

1. Pay for your water meter at Green Oak Charter Township Treasurer's Office. The price includes the water meter, MXU radio read unit, and inspection fees. You will need to fill out a meter order information application.
2. Contact a plumber from the approved plumber list. You will be responsible for negotiating a price and paying the plumber for their service.
3. Once the plumber has completed the work, an **inspection** must be performed. Plumbing inspections are done on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursdays each week. Please set up an appointment through the Green Oak Charter Township Building Department. 48 hours notice is required.
4. Upon completion of the inspection, call Highland Treatment for final installation of your meter and MXU meter read unit. 72 hours notice is required.

PLUMBER RESONSIBILITY

1. Let the Green Oak Township Treasurer's Office know what homeowner(s) you will be working with. We will verify that the meter has been paid for and give you a "template" kit or copper horn to plumb in.
2. One the work is completed, have the homeowner make arrangements to have the **required** inspection.
3. Upon inspection approval, Highland Treatment will be called to install the final water meter unit.
