(c) HOLIDAY BAZAAR: 16 tables sold so far. Discussed splitting vendor tables between two rooms of senior center. Bake Sale will be held in new meeting room. Food trucks discussed for serving food. October Newsletter will ask for volunteers and bakers. (d) KIWANIS LUNCH: With ongoing pandemic limit at Kiwanis lunch will be 50. Tickets will still be \$5 per person. **New Business:** (a) LESA WORK READINESS PROGRAM: Program designed to give high school students with disabilities an opportunity to gain employment experience.
