



Upcoming treatments to the Lower Huron River Chain of Lakes are scheduled

HERBICIDE TREATMENT:

This is your advanced notice for treatment. Treatment notices are not pre-posted on the shoreline.

Treatment is currently scheduled to **start the week of August 28.**

The most up to date schedule for treatment can be found [here](#). Please check back frequently as weather or State of Michigan restrictions can change treatment dates.

YELLOW notices will be posted along the shoreline the day of treatment.

If your property does NOT get a **YELLOW** treatment notice:

- Your property is NOT impacted by herbicide treatment
- There are NO water use restrictions in front of your property

If your property **DOES** receive a **YELLOW** treatment notice:

- Reference the posted notice for exact water use restrictions

New research shows that operation of wake boats can potentially threaten lake health. Several recent studies show that wake boats can produce waves of 1.7 to 17 times the energy of those created by other comparably sized power boats. These larger waves can damage property and cause shoreline erosion, decrease water clarity and plant abundance, and add excess nutrients that contribute to poor water quality.
