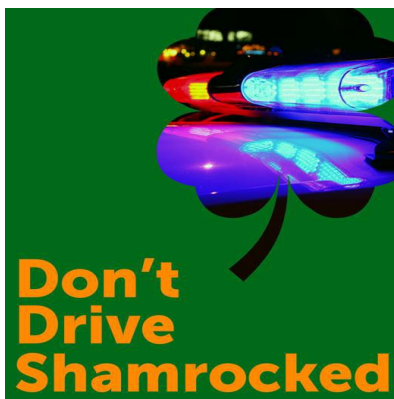

Be sure to add everyone **in your household** when creating your account and don't forget to opt in for cancellation notifications via email or text. Your new household account will provide you with registration history, transaction receipts and much more! The account will be used for daily fees and concession purchases too. Once your account is set up, you can go into the "Programs" feature to select what you would like to purchase--family or individual memberships, swimming lessons and tiny tots lessons. Your memberships will be attached to a card for each family member that will have a bar code and photo linked to each person. Dates will be announced for getting the membership cards and photos prior to the opening of the Aquatic Center.
