City of Kasson Utility Billing Credit Card Users Announcement

As of April 28th, the City will be migrating to a new credit/debit card processor for the payment of Utility Bills. Upon clicking the link, customers can pay by credit/debit card as a “one-time payment” each time they pay, or, set up recurring payments for their convenience. You will need to know your WEB ID which is on your statement. Utility customers will have other options to review their utility account. User information is only through that portal with PCI protections with, as now, no information stored on any City site. The user fee will continue to be paid by the City for utility bill payments.
