The City Council will be appointing an individual to serve the remainder of a term, from July 1, 2021 to December 31, 2022 on the Council due to a resignation. In order to be eligible for consideration, the individual must be an eligible voter in the City, must be at least 21 years of age and must be a resident of the City for at least 30 days prior to the appointment.
