No, not recyclable—but reusable. Easter baskets, grass, plastic eggs, and toy bunnies have a long shelf-life if they're well-cared for and stored properly. For more recycling information, visit [RecycleSpot.org](#).



Those padded plastic Amazon mailers can be recycled—in a few simple steps. First, remove all items from the mailer. Second, remove the shipping label (the paper and adhesive are contaminants for plastic film recyclers). Finally, bring the mailer back to a retail store with a plastic bag collection bin. Please don't put them in your recycling bin. Find a spot to recycle them at [RecycleSpot.org](#).



Just a reminder that only metal cans (including aerosol), and aluminum trays and foil (2" ball) can go in your recycling bin. Other metal items (such as pots and pans, hardware, BBQ grills, window screens, and curtain rods) need to go to a scrap metal bin at a recycling center or a scrap metal dealer.
