

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

**12TH STREET CULVERT REPLACEMENT
CITY OF KEARNEY, MISSOURI**

Sealed bids for 12th Street Culvert Replacement Project will be received by the City of Kearney, at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, located at 100 E. Washington Street, Kearney, MO 64060, until 10:00 a.m. local time on March 23, 2023. At that time, all sealed bids will be transferred to the City Council Chamber, City Hall, where they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Any bid received after the designated closing time will be returned unopened.

All bids shall be submitted in sealed envelopes addressed to the City Administrator of Kearney, Missouri, and marked "12TH STREET CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT". Plans and specifications are on file at the office of the City Clerk and the Consulting Engineer, Lamp Rynearson, 9001 State Line Road, Suite 200, Kansas City, Missouri 64114.

Prospective bidders desiring copies of plans, specifications, bid documents, and other Contract Documents can purchase on-line at Drexel Technologies in their eDistribution Plan Room at www.drexeltech.com. Additional assistance is available at distribution@drexeltech.com or 913.371.4430. Information regarding this project can be found under the "Public Jobs" link on the website. Partial sets of bidding documents will not be available from Drexel or Lamp Rynearson. (email: greg.vanpatten@lamprynearson.com). Bidding documents will be shipped only if the requesting party assumes responsibility for all related charges. Corporate, certified, or cashier's checks shall be made payable to Drexel Technologies, Inc.

CONTRACTORS SHOULD READ AND BE FULLY FAMILIAR WITH ALL DOCUMENTS BEFORE SUBMITTING A BID. IN SUBMITTING A BID, THE BIDDER WARRANTS THAT HE HAS READ THE DOCUMENTS AND IS FULLY FAMILIAR THEREWITH AND THAT HE HAS VISITED THE SITE OF THE WORK TO FULLY INFORM HIMSELF AS TO ALL EXISTING CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS AND SHALL INCLUDE IN HIS BID A SUM TO COVER THE COST OF ALL ITEMS OF THE WORK.

All bidders shall verify that they have considered all written addenda. Neither the City nor the City's Engineer shall be responsible for oral instructions.

Any written addenda issued during the time of bidding shall be covered and included in the bid. There will be no clarifications or exceptions allowed on bids. Bids are for a total package, total contract price. Bids shall be made upon the form provided, in ink or typewritten. Numbers shall be stated both in writing and in figures; the signature shall be long hand; and the complete form shall be without alteration or erasure. On alternate items for which a bid is not submitted, a written indication of "no bid" on the bid is required.

Provisions: The following provisions are required of the successful contractor and are further described in the bid packet:

- Prevailing Wage per Clay County Wage Order No. 29, pursuant to RSMo 290.250;
- Performance Bond for no less than 100% of the cost of project construction for projects in excess of \$50,000;
- Enrollment in Federal Work Authorization Program Bidders are informed that pursuant to Section 285.530, RSMo, as a condition of the award of any contract in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), the successful bidder shall, by sworn affidavit and provision of

documentation, affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection to the contracted services. Successful bidders shall also sign an affidavit affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection to the contracted services.

- Safety Training Bidders are informed that the Project is subject to the requirements of Section 292.675, RSMo, which requires all contractors or subcontractors doing work on the Project to provide, and require its on-site employees to complete, a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (“OSHA”) or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. The training must be completed within sixty (60) days of the date work on the Project commences. On-site employees found on the worksite without documentation of the required training shall have twenty (20) days to produce such documentation.

No oral, telegraphic, facsimile or telephonic bids or alterations will be considered.

The following items must be included in the sealed envelope with the bid:

- a. Bid
- b. 5% Bid Security—Bid Bond, Cashier’s Check or Certified Check (See Below)

Each bidder shall file with his bid, a cashier’s check or a certified check drawn on any acceptable bank, made payable to the City of Kearney, Kansas, in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid, which shall be retained by the City of Kearney until a Contract for the project has been executed. Bid bonds will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders, with the exception of the second qualifying bidder, at such time as their bids are rejected. The bid deposit of the successful bidder and the second qualifying bidder will be returned when satisfactory bonds in the amount equal to 100% of the Contract amount, required insurance certificates and other required documents have been furnished and the Contract Documents have been executed.

In the event the successful bidder is unable to execute the Contract, for whatever reason, the City may exercise its legal prerogatives, including, but not limited to, enforcement of its rights as to the bid security.
