

Lake County offers the best parts of rural life. It offers a chance to get out of the city and do some exploring. If you're the kind of person who enjoys the thrill of discovery, you've come to the right place. Here's a list of 51 things to do in Lake County. Think of it as a guidebook and the beginning of a new adventure.

GET ACTIVE

- Climb Mount Konociti** One must-do in Lake County is to climb Mt. Konociti. Standing in the middle of the county, this dormant volcano erupted less than 10,000 years ago and towers over Clear Lake with an elevation of 4,300 feet above sea level. The approximately five-mile hike follows a steady grade and will reward you with spectacular views.
- Hike Clear Lake State Park** Located on the shores of North America's oldest lake, Clear Lake State Park has several trails, a nature center, and plenty of camping, swimming, and fishing opportunities.
- Hike Anderson Marsh State Historic Park** This nature reserve on the shores of Clear Lake preserves a tule marsh, archaeological sites of the Pomo people, and historic ranch structures. Try the five-mile round-trip hike along the marsh, ending at the mouth of Cache Creek.
- Find a Diamond** One of Mount Konociti's many eruptions spread diamonds across Lake County. These quartz crystals can only be found here and vary in color from clear to a purple-pink hue.
- Go Rockhounding** Mount Konociti's many eruptions created a unique place for rock hounds. Pick up huge chunks of obsidian on Bottle Rock Road, or scour the ground for jasper and thunder eggs at Cache Creek Wilderness.
- Bike the Back Roads** Lake County's a rural place, meaning that it's filled with back roads that wind and wander through oak forests, climb to mountain peaks, and skirt around Clear Lake. Wherever you choose, you'll be sure to have a fantastic ride.
- Go Bird-Watching** With nearly 300 bird species either residing here or stopping for a while as they pass through, Lake County is a bird-watcher's paradise. Spend time at Clear Lake State Park watching the egrets and green herons spearing frogs, or head to Rodman Slough to see the American white pelicans wing in for the evening.
- Go Hunting** If you're looking for a trophy buck or a turkey dinner, Lake County's the place. Pack up the truck and spend a couple of weeks roaming the 900,000-acre Mendocino National Forest.
- Catch a Largemouth Bass** Clear Lake is the undisputed champion of bass fishing and is known as the Bass Capital of the West for good reason. Anglers frequently catch six- to eight-pound bass, and it's not uncommon to hear of them bringing in 10-pounders. Plus, the lake's filled with monster catfish.
- Play and Explore on Clear Lake** Clear Lake's not just North America's oldest lake; it's also the largest natural lake in California. That means there's plenty of room to feel the rush and create wicked waves on a jet ski. Looking for something more relaxing? On summer mornings, Clear Lake's dead calm. Usually, only a whisper of wind blows across the broad basin, making it the best time to pull out your SUP and paddle with the grebes through the waters.

HISTORY

- Check Out Ely Stage Stop and Country Museum** The Ely Stage Stop is more than just a museum. It's also home to a monthly Fiddlers' Jam, where the best bluegrass musicians in the area come to have a foot-stomping good time. And be sure to wander past all the old farm equipment and recreated blacksmith shop up to the fully restored stage stop.
- Tour Our Museums** See the world's largest collection of Eastern Pomo basketry at the Historic Courthouse Museum. Sip estate-grown wines and spend a few hours visiting a rare wooden boat collection at Boatique Winery. Take a trip down memory lane at Clarke's Collectibles and Lunchbox Museum, which owner Deb Clarke has filled with thousands of lunchboxes, retro toys, classic Americana, and carnival games.
- Visit Historic Kelseyville** Kelseyville is a relaxed town with plenty to keep you busy; it's filled with gift shops, clothing boutiques, wineries, jewelry stores, bakeries, and restaurants. Spend a weekend with its pleasant people, and you may never want to leave.
- Follow a Quilt Trail** The first of its kind in California, the Lake County Quilt Trail features over 120 famous and whimsical wooden quilt blocks displayed on barns, historic homes, and local businesses. The trail wanders through Lake County. You may think you're lost, but then a beautiful eight-foot red, white, and blue quilt will appear out of nowhere on the side of an 1800s barn.

GET WET

- Boat at Blue Lakes** The waters at Blue Lakes are deep, clear, and inviting, meaning it's a perfect place to downshift, rent an electric boat, and find a hidden area of the lake to sunbathe and swim.
- Kayak the Water Trails** Nature moves at its own pace, and the most peaceful way to experience it is on Clear Lake, a place primal in its beauty. Lake County has seven different water trails, all perfect for exploring on your kayak.
- Water Ski** There's always somewhere on Clear Lake with smooth water; that's one of the perks of being California's largest natural freshwater lake. You're sure to find a perfect place to carve big, beautiful sprays.
- Throw a Pontoon Boat Party** You may not be able to make it to Clear Lake on the Fourth of July when the boats raft up. Everyone waits to watch one of the county's four fireworks shows arch upward, reflecting their colors in the waters. But even so, Lake County has long, warm summer days, and it's worth it to have a good party on the water. Disney's Boat Rentals is a good place to start.

OFF THE BEATEN PATH

- Off-Road on Cow Mountain** With 23,000 acres of OHV land, Cow Mountain's a perfect place to practice your off-road skills. How technical do you like it? It doesn't matter; you'll find it here.
- Practice Yoga With a Goat** Reese Ranch Retreat offers more than lodging. It's a place to slow down, step out of the rat race, and reset. There are few better ways to do that than an hour-long yoga session with one of the ranch's goats.
- Visit the Geysers** Lake County is home to the largest geothermal facility in the world: The Geysers. Spend a day touring the massive facility, marveling at the enormous generators and seeing the fumaroles steam.
- Soak in a 112-degree tub at Harbin** Harbin Hot Springs is known throughout the world and is also one of the top 10 places in the nation to receive a massage. But it's more than just hot springs. It's a complete retreat center with classes, programs, and the Shiatsu Watsu, a custom creation that combines Shiatsu massage with warm water.
- Visit a Saffron Farm** Each fall, Peace and Plenty Farm, North America's largest saffron farm, harvests the tiny blue flowers that contain the thin, orange-brown threads of saffron. It's three weeks of backbreaking work that produces one of the world's most prized flavors.
- Stay in a Casita on the Lake** Hotels and cabins not your cup of tea? For a unique experience, stay in a Mediterranean-style casita at Ceago Vinegarden instead.
- Cut Zinnias** Located in Big Valley, Renker Farms is a Lake County tradition. Its beautiful setting makes it the perfect place to pick everything from peaches to pumpkins to zinnias.
- See a Play** Every summer, the Lake County Theatre Company puts on Shakespeare at the Lake. Set outdoors on the shores of Clear Lake, the plays are performed by local thespians, who recreate the bard's works for your enjoyment.

- Play a Game** Try your luck at one of our Native American casinos and resorts. Win or lose, when it comes to a good time, you've hit the jackpot. Twin Pine Casino & Hotel boasts some of the best table games, while the Robinson Rancheria Resort & Casino offers the largest casino floor in Lake County — 10,000 square feet!
- EcoArts Sculpture Walk** Rebuilt on the ashes of the devastating 2015 Valley Fire, EcoArts Sculpture Walk is an annual seasonal exhibit of regional artists who install works in an outdoor setting with new trees rising around it. It serves as a testament to the power of this community.
- Have Lunch at a Flower Farm** Visit Bell Haven Flower Farm to enjoy a peaceful afternoon in 3.5+ acres of dahlias, roses, anemones, and lilies, then enjoy lunch while overlooking scenic Clear Lake.
- Rest Your Caboose in a Caboose** Spend the night at Featherbed Railroad Bed & Breakfast Resort, which features nine antique railroad cabooses, each distinctively decorated with an individual theme. Then wake up to a full breakfast and watch the sunrise on Clear Lake.
- Sleep in a Tree** Much more impressive than a typical backyard treehouse, Pine Grove Resort lets you sleep in a majestic forest retreat of timeless natural beauty and swim in spring-fed pools.
- Go Straight to Jail** The Lower Lake Stone Jail is a California Historic Landmark, built in 1876 during the height of the quicksilver mining boom. It has an interesting story—the builders were the first to get arrested, put in jail, and the first to break out. The building wasn't completely finished and they lifted the rafters to escape.

EAT

- Dine in a Barn** Grab a seat at the table at The Ripe Choice Farm & Catering, a 100-year-old barn converted into a contemporary studio space. But watch where you step; you might bump into the nearly 100-year-old tortoise who wanders the property.
- Dine on a Mountaintop** For a flagship tasting experience, Ogulin Estate is tops. Literally. Enjoy 360 vineyard views from 2,300 feet atop Shannon Ridge Home Ranch.
- Eat BBQ on Highway 53** Keep your eyes peeled and your appetite ready for this "blink and you'll miss it," cult favorite Danny's Roadhouse Kitchen, known for its massively delicious ribs and barbecue done Texas-style.
- Dine on a Runway** RED'S @ the Skyroom is known for "California Comfort Cuisine," which means the food's high quality and sure to please. Fly in for a bite, or just show up and watch the planes land at Lamson Field.
- Visit a Farmers Market** Enjoy local meat, produce, and warm conversation at one of our farmers markets, all at beautiful locations throughout the county.
- Pick Berries** Pick your own raspberries and blackberries at Edenberry's U-Pick Farm, located in the heart of Big Valley. Be sure to sample some of their spectacular jams and vinegars.

SHOOT

- Disc Golf** Play a round of disc golf under the oaks at the beautiful and rugged Highland Springs Recreation Area, where the grassy hills roll down to the reservoir.
- Shoot 18 at Hidden Valley Lake** With California's clearest skies, you'll always be able to see your ball hit the fairway from Lake County's Billy Bell-designed course.
- Play Mountain Golf** This Jack Fleming-designed, nine-hole course at Adams Springs is as breathtaking as it is challenging. Forewarning: When you play golf on a mountain, regular golf will never feel the same. And don't forget to check out Mountain Meadows Gold on top of Cobb Mountain.

DANCE

- Go to a Blues Fest at a Saloon** Kick up your heels at the Blue Wing Saloon Restaurant at the historic Tallman Hotel, an authentic recreation of the town's original 1870s saloon and known for bringing in some of the region's finest blues musicians.
- Get Down With a Band** Austin Park in Clearlake and Library Park in Lakeport offer a series of free Friday night concerts in the summer months. Kelseyville offers Kickin' in the Country street dance every third Thursday night in June, July, August, and September.

SIP

- Taste high-elevation wine! We're wine country's fastest-growing region for a reason: our unique volcanic terroir creates a distinct minerality that makes our wines some of the best around.**
- Taste Award-Winning Wines** Sip back and relax as you savor a selection of award-winning artisan wines in a Mediterranean-inspired setting at Thorn Hill Vineyards. Explore a wine cave at Lajour Winery with nosebleed views of Lake County from the famous Red Hills AVA.
 - Sip Estate Wines** Taste handcrafted, artisan wines in High Valley AVA, located on the 2,900-acre Brassfield Estate Winery. Choose from more than 10 wines in The Mercantile, the buzzy tasting room from Shannon Family of Wines.
 - Discover "Wild Diamonds"** Discover the local legend of the "wild diamond," and sip the legendary Bordeaux varietal wines, at Wild Diamond Vineyards. Afterward, search for quartz crystals at the 2,200-foot mountaintop winery.
 - Drink Craft Beer** Grab a pint of your new favorite lager, ale, porter, or maybe even a sour, made with fresh, local ingredients at Kelsey Creek Brewing or O'Meara Bros. Brewing Company.
 - Sip Sparkling Pear Wine** Our distinctive wines get their flavor from grapes grown in volcanic soil. But for a unique flavor, you'll love sipping the sparkling pear wine at Mt. Konociti Winery, located in a former pear packing shed.
 - Take a Spin at Six Sigma Ranch and Winery** Enjoy scenic views of a 4,300-acre ranch and vineyard by hopping on a Pinzgauer (a WWII-era troop hauler) and taking a tour! Learn about this location's unique history, sip on great wine, and enjoy beautiful hiking and biking trails.
 - Taste Olive Oil** Get a taste of Tuscany in Kellyville at the Chacewater Winery & Olive Mill, known for crafting award-winning wines and oils. Surrounded by olive groves, the mill offers regular tours and irregular views.
 - Play Bocce at Boatique Winery** Nestled in the famed Red Hills AVA, where the red dirt hides tiny flecks of Lake County diamonds and creates a distinctive terroir, Boatique Winery's an excellent place to spend an afternoon. Grab a bottle of its high-quality wines and relax with some friends over a game of bocce, or just sit back and enjoy the scenery.
