Documentation needed to apply (in addition to the completed application on the back of this form):

- A copy of the parent's / guardian's 2022 income tax summary sheet showing the total annual income and number of dependents (social security number should be blacked out prior to submitting the form). The child that is listed on the scholarship app must be listed as a dependent on the income tax summary page.

Scholarship Application Guidelines:

- Applications must be completely filled out and have all supporting documentation
- Completed applications and supporting documents must be turned in at the Central Park Performing Arts Center business offices or emailed to CPPAC@largo.com
- Submitting a scholarship application does not reserve a space for your child in the class. Please register for the class (if possible) before submitting an application
- Scholarships will be offered until all scholarship funds are distributed or the class is full.
- If approved for a scholarship, the family will be responsible for paying the remaining balance of the class one week prior to the start of class. Students cannot attend the class with an outstanding balance.
- A City of Largo Recreation, Parks and Arts Membership Card is required to register for the class. This fee is not covered under the scholarship funding.
