### DEPARTMENT SPONSORED EVENTS

During the month of October, Largo Fire participated in 22 public events that reached approximately 1,450 people in the areas of fire safety programs, home safety preparedness programs and fall prevention. Ten smoke detectors were installed.

### BUDGET UPDATE

For the month of October, Fire has experienced a total of 2229.50 hours of overtime. Minimum staffing accounted for 44.9% or 1001.75 hours of the overtime at a cost of \$35,525.07. Special events, department committees, and training account for the remainder of the overtime assignments.
