FBI VCAC:

A detective is currently assigned to the FBI VCAC (Violent Crimes Against Children) Task Force as a part-time task force member working with the FBI, Florida Department of Law Enforcement, and local jurisdictions to combat cyber crimes related to children. Cases for the month include:

Special Operations Unit (SOU):

CALEA 43.1.1 Vice, Drugs & Organized Crime Investigation:

Detective Zimny worked a script fraud case that resulted in 33 separate charges. The case is currently at the SAO waiting on a warrant. The subject is out of county.

The LSD cases that Detective Hartwell has been purchasing came back from PCFL positive for Acid.

Homeland Security has adopted our controlled delivery Fentanyl case. They were able to obtain an indictment and warrants. Detective Fernandez coordinated with our Federal counterparts and arrested the subjects developing more State charges for possession incident to arrest. This case was originally carried to the SAO who plead the two subjects out to probation for 100 grams of Fentanyl.
