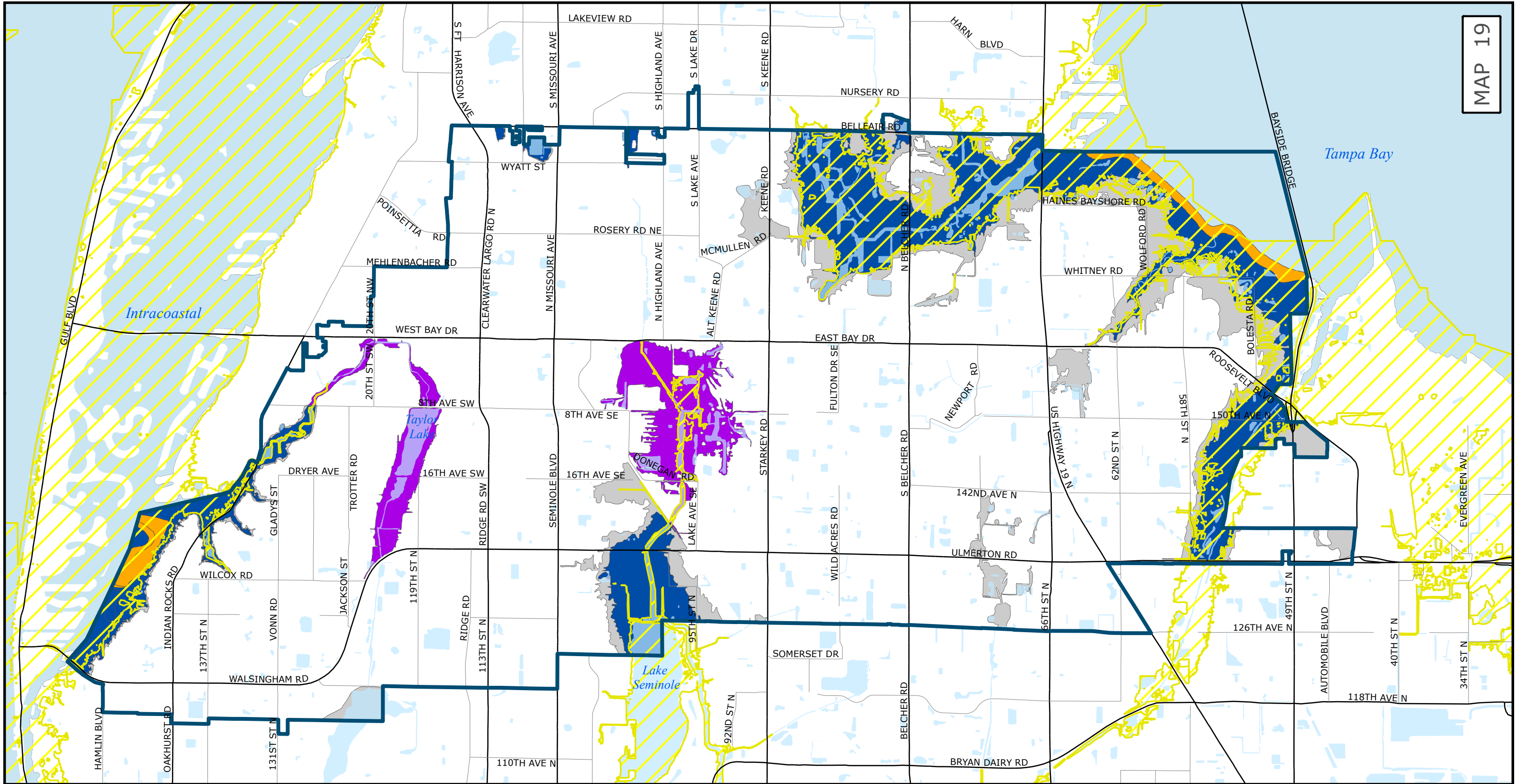

Elements

Special Flood Hazard Area/SFHA
(1 % Annual Chance or 100 Year)

- A Zone
- AE Zone
- VE Zone

Moderate Flood Hazard Area
(0.2% Annual Chance or 500 Year Flood)

- X Zone (Shaded)

Minimal Flood Hazard Area (Areas outside the SFHA and higher than the elevation of the 0.2% Annual Chance)

- X Zone (Unshaded, White Space)

National Hurricane Center Storm Surge Model

- Coastal High Hazard Area/CHHA

"The Coastal High Hazard Area (CHHA) is the area below the elevation of the category 1 storm surge line as established by....a computerized storm surge model" [Florida Statute Section 163.3178 (2)(h)]. The SLOSH model is used by the NHC to forecast storm surge and model storm surge vulnerability [<https://www.nhc.noaa.gov/surge/slosh.php>].
