Fire Authority Board:

We responded to 83 total incidents for the month of February. We had no major incidents last month. We have responded to 166 total requests for service to date in 2021, an increase of 29 calls over the same time frame in 2020.

We installed 63 smoke detectors and 36 CO alarms in the area.

A utility box was built for Brush 8 and the Chief truck to hold equipment.

Following DOT inspections on Engine 3, it was found the brakes were in need of replacing as well as several valves. This \$5600.00 bill was covered be the County Fire Commission. Engine 5 and Medic 9 had to have the batteries replaced.

We officially hired our eighth new probationary member Bringing our roster to 29 members.

Our four members who were in in the EMT class at Grattan have successfully completed the class. Three more members will be starting the next round of EMT March 22.




