7. NEW BUSINESS

a. Fee Schedule Updates

During our recent workshop we reviewed city ordinances and identified several fees that have not been established by the council or need to be updated. Attached is a list of those fees with recommendations.

Recommended Motion: That the Lowell City Council adopt an addendum to the fee schedule as presented.

b. Purchasing Ordinance and Policy

During your last meeting I presented a change to the city ordinances on purchasing and bidding that would update our current procedures. The ordinance itself has not been updated in more than 20 years. Presented for your consideration are an ordinance amendment and a resolution to adopt the updated purchasing and bidding policy. You will need to take two separate actions.

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Recommended Motions:

- 1. That the Lowell City Council adopt the Ordinance to Amend Sections 2-71 and 2-72 to provide for the development and approval a purchasing and bidding policy.
- 2. That the Lowell City Council adopt the Resolution to Approve the Purchasing and Bidding Policy.
- c. Solid Waste Management Plan Update Discussion Only

We have received a revised update of the Kent County Solid Waste Management Plan. The update will require approval from local municipalities in order for it to become effective. It is on your agenda today for information only and to provide local citizens with notice that we are being asked to approve the amendment. I will be contacting Kent County Department of Public Works for additional discussion and will make a recommendation at a future council meeting.

d. Downtown Environmental Scan

Bruce Johnston of Revitalize, LLC, the contractor who is working with us on the rental rehab program, has assisted us in securing a proposal from an environmental consultant to perform a limited site assessment on the city's downtown area. The goal will be to identify potential environmental concerns that could help the city secure future funding to provide full environmental assessments and potential clean-up of brownfield sites.

Recommended Motion: That the Lowell City Council approves an agreement with Triterra environmental consultants at a fee of \$1,500 to provide a limited environmental site assessment of the city's downtown.
