### **DESCRIPTION**

This position is responsible for performing grounds maintenance, landscaping, and minor building repairs including building structures, enhancing habitats, repairing fences, and assisting with other projects on the Zoo grounds.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- High School Diploma/GED
- Valid Texas Driver's License
- Six (6) months of experience working in maintenance and/or landscape trades
- Must be able to work holidays and weekends

### **KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES**

- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with fellow staff members, other City employees, and outside contractors
