Overdose Prevention

- **WHAT: NARCAN or NALOXONE**
Medication that can reverse an overdose caused by an opioid drug such as heroin or prescription pain medications.
- **WHY: SAVING LIVES**
When people are trained in giving Naloxone, they can potentially save someone's life and reduce health care costs.
- **HOW: HOUSE BILL 170**
Naloxone can now be prescribed to any friend, family member or other individual willing to provide assistance to an individual at risk of experiencing an opioid-related overdose.

Narcan Distribution

Naloxone, or Narcan, is an opioid overdose reversal medication. Our purpose is to supply Narcan to individuals, and their loved ones, who are at risk of an opioid overdose. Kits are available at no cost after individuals receive a short training from our staff.
